CHC Inc. CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I. NAME

This ministry shall be known as Christian Horse-lover's Club Inc., abbreviated CHC Inc. Established on September 2000, by Kim Shanks in Whitewater WI.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE

The Statement of Purpose of Christian Horse-lover's Club Inc. shall be...

- #1. To Reach people for Jesus Christ**, to bring them to know Jesus as their personal Savior and help them grow their relationship with Christ.
 - CHC Inc. is a non denominational program.
- #2. To Teach Bible truth** in a unique way by applying God's Word to life and to horses.
 - A) To Teach Christian principles for living each day, to develop good relationships with family, friends and community, while working with horses.
 - B) To Teach safety, care, communication, and much more information about horses.
 - To teach and encourage those who love horses, but do not have one.
 - To teach and encourage those who have some horse experience or those who have a horse.
- #3. To disciple and mentor** young Believers or any Believers of any age:
 - To love the Lord their God with all their heart, soul, strength and mind.
 - To help them grow in their relationship with Christ, teaching practical scriptural principles for personal growth and living and applying them to their interest and love for horses.
 - To build caring relationships and enjoy Christian fellowship while learning about horses.
- #4. To provide** mature Christian experienced horse owners, who desire to reach out for Christ into their own community, with CHC curriculum and information on how to run a Christian Horse-lover's Club successfully on their own ranch or farm.
 - The program is originally designed as a girls club, but the curriculum is not limited therein, for it can be adapted to a boys club or families, or couples, or ladies club.
- #5.** To elect its own officers and to arrange for its own meetings and to govern itself.
- #6.** Incidental to, or in connection therewith, it shall have the right to purchase, own, hold in trust, use, sell, convey, mortgage, leased, or otherwise dispose of such property, real or chattel, as may be needed for the prosecution of its work.
- #7.** To serve as an organization exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE III. STATEMENT OF FAITH

The Bible is our all-sufficient rule for faith and practice. This Statement of Faith is intended simply as a basis of fellowship among us (ex. that we all speak the same thing, I Cor. 12:10, Acts 2:42). The phraseology employed in this statement is not inspired or contended for, but the truth set forth is held to be essential to this ministry and not specific to any certain denomination.

No claim is made that it contains all Biblical truth, only that it covers our need as to these fundamental doctrines.

CHC Inc. STATEMENT OF FAITH

WE BELIEVE.....

#1) ...The Bible (both Old Testament and New Testament) is the inspired, infallible and only authoritative written Word of God. It is the supreme and final authority in all matters on which it speaks.

#2) ...There is one God, Creator of all, and He is infinitely perfect and eternally existent in three Persons: the Father, Son and Holy Spirit - each of whom possesses equally all the attributes of Deity.

#3) ...Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. We believe in His sinless life, in His miracles, that He died on the cross as a pure sacrifice for our sins. He arose bodily from the dead and ascended to the right hand of the Father where He lives to make intercession for us. Jesus Christ will come again to the earth – personally, visibly and bodily – to consummate history and the eternal plan of God.

#4) ...Man was created in the image of God but fell from grace, into sin, and is therefore lost. Every man is in need of salvation, which comes from repentance and faith in the shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection. This provides the ONLY ground for justification and salvation.

#5) ...The ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ. As such, He indwells, guides, helps and instructs, empowering the true Believer for godly living and service.

#6) ...The true Church is composed of ALL those who are spiritually born again (John 3:3) by accepting Jesus as their personal Savior. Through the new birth we are united together in the body of Christ. Jesus Christ is the head of the Church.

#7) ...There shall be a bodily resurrection of the dead. The Believers will enter into everlasting joy with the Lord and the unbelievers to judgment and everlasting, conscious punishment.

BYLAWS**

ARTICLE I QUALIFICATIONS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

Spiritual Requirements:

Each of the Officers and Board of Directors shall: agree with, uphold and support the CHC Statement of Purpose and CHC Inc. Statement of Faith, be a born-again Believer (John 3:3) who lives and shows the quality of a spiritual leader, who is mature in the faith with a desire to serve others, be a regular church attender at a local church and must be in good standing with the CHC organization.

- 1. The President:** The President shall uphold the above *spiritual requirements*. He/she shall be the chairman of any committees and shall conduct all the business meetings. He/she shall perform all the duties which properly belong to the scriptural ideal of a Believer serving the Lord Jesus in sincere Christian ministry and under the headship and authority of the Lord Jesus. He/she shall appoint all members of the Board of Directors.
- 2. The Vice-President:** The Vice-President shall uphold the above *Spiritual Requirements*. He/she shall be appointed by the President and shall preside over any business and committee meetings in which the President is unable to attend.
- 3. The Treasurer:** The Treasurer shall uphold the above *Spiritual Requirements*. He/she shall keep accurate, up-to-date records of all finances for the ministry and abide by all state and federal laws for a non-profit entity. He/she shall be appointed by the President. He/she shall keep itemized records of all receipts and disbursements and shall make an annual report of those records.
- 4. The Secretary:** The Secretary shall uphold the above *Spiritual Requirements*. He/she shall be appointed by the President, shall keep accurate record of the minutes of the board meetings and help organize correspondence for the ministry.

**ARTICLE II
BOARD OF DIRECTORS:**

1. The Board of Directors shall agree with and uphold the above *Spiritual Requirements*.
2. The Board of Directors shall be appointed by the President of the corporation annually.
3. The Board of Directors shall meet at the call of the President to conduct routine business of the corporation.

**ARTICLE III
LEADER REQUIREMENTS FOR A CHARTERED Christian Horse-lover's Club INC.**

1. A Chartered CHC Inc. leader must agree with, uphold and support the CHC Inc. Statement of Purpose and CHC Inc. Statement of Faith. A Chartered CHC Inc. leader must...
 - a) Be a born again Believer (John 3:3) who lives and shows the quality of a spiritual leader who is growing in his/her faith and has a desire to minister (reach and teach) others.
 - b) Be a regular church attender at a local church.
 - c) Know how to intelligently and safely handle horses and have a desire to teach others about horses.

2. Requirements to be a Chartered CHC Inc. leader – that is, a leader registered and approved to run a local CHC Inc.

a) The CHC Inc. chartered club applicant must complete the CHC Inc. *Leadership Application* and supply the references requested and send in required funds for a background check.

b) The CHC Inc. chartered club applicant must be approved by the CHC Board of Directors according to his/her answers on the CHC Inc. *Leadership Application*. The applicant's qualifications include spiritual and ministry experience, horse experience (including safety), positive responses from his/her references and a positive background check.

3. A Chartered CHC Inc. leader must agree to operate the club and use the CHC Inc. curriculum with integrity and in accordance to the CHC Inc. *Leadership Guide*. A Chartered CHC Inc. leader must purchase a Leadership Guide and return the signed Certificate of Completion to verify the complete reading of the Leadership Guide.

4. It is highly recommended that a Chartered CHC Inc. leader work to complete the Leadership Unit as well as, work with her club to complete all the CHC Inc. units.

5. A CHC leader may be disqualified by the Board of Directors as a Chartered CHC Inc. leader if it is proven that he/she is not upholding the above CHC Inc. requirements 1-3 of Article III.

ARTICLE IV FINANCES:

1. All funds needed for the maintenance of the CHC Inc. ministry shall be provided for by voluntary contributions, suggested voluntary registration from club participants, offerings from churches and friends of the CHC Inc. ministry and corporation and shall be administered by the officers for the use of the CHC Inc. ministry at their discretion.

2. The fiscal year of file ministry shall be September to August.

ARTICLE V DISSOLUTION CLAUSE:

1. In the event this ministry / corporation ceases to function for the purposes herein set forth, then all property, real or chattel, and all assets remaining after satisfying debts and obligations shall revert to: "S.M.I.L.E.S." (of Delevan WI) or Cowboys for Christ, or Crystal Lyons Ministries or similar nonprofit organization. The Board of Directors shall disperse all assets as it seems fit. The nonprofit organization receiving the assets shall forthwith have full authority to use or dispense of the property at its discretion. In event of the sale of said property by the non-profit organization, the proceeds derived therefrom shall be used by the non-profit organization.
